Note-Taking Templates Pack

Five writable A4 pages, one per method: Cornell, outline, mapping, charting, and sentence notes. Import into your note app or print, duplicate a page per lecture, and let the material choose the method.

START HERE

Import the pack, duplicate the page

Every template is a plain A4 PDF page, so any app that annotates PDFs can write on it. Keep this file as your clean master. Duplicate the page you need for each lecture instead of writing on the original.

SET IT UP IN YOUR APP

1 GoodNotes

Import the PDF as a document. To reuse a page forever, take a screenshot-free route: Settings → Notebook Templates → import the page, then pick it when adding pages.

2 Notability

Import the PDF, then use the page manager to duplicate the template page before each class. Drag pages to reorder by subject.

3 Noteful

Import the PDF, long-press the template page, and choose duplicate. You can also save a page as a custom template for new pages.

4 Paper

Print at 100% scale on A4 (no fit-to-page shrinking). The line spacing is sized for normal handwriting.

PICK THE RIGHT PAGE

Cornell	Default for ordinary lectures. Notes right, cues left after class, summary at the bottom.
Outline	The lecture or chapter already has a clear hierarchy of headings and subpoints.
Mapping	The value sits in relationships: cycles, systems, causes and effects.
Charting	Every item is judged on the same attributes. Set the column headers before class.
Sentence	Fast or unstructured sessions. Capture one idea per line, reorganize after class.

One rule. The page is not the study step. After class, add cues or headings while the session is fresh, then review by covering the page and retrieving the ideas from memory. A boring template you review beats a beautiful one you archive.

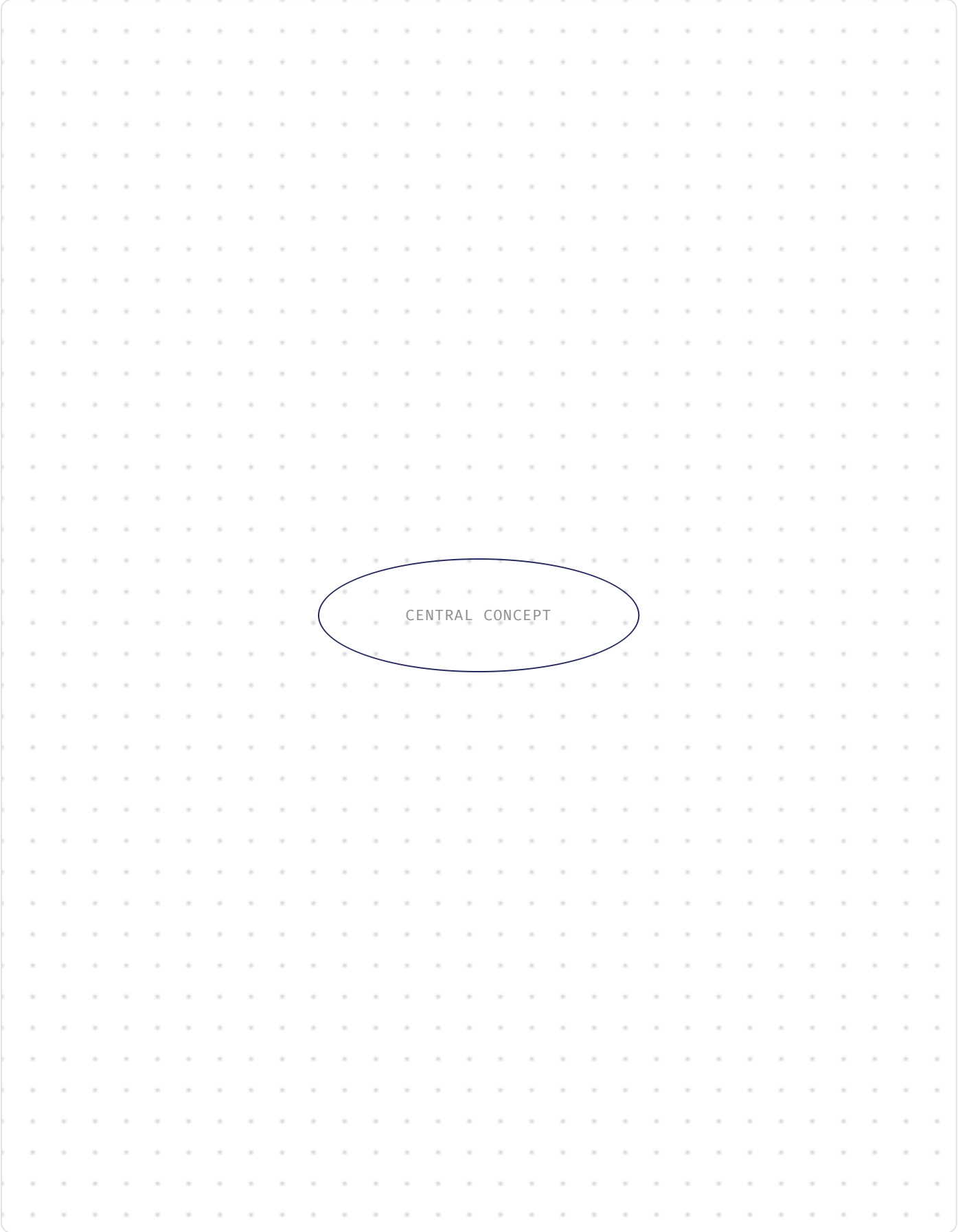
